



Fabric 2	10515-N	3/8 yard
Fabric 3	10513-N	3/8 yard
Fabric 4	10516-N	3/8 yard
Fabric 5	10514-R	3/8 yard
Fabric 6	10515-R	3/8 yard
Fabric 7	10513-R	3/8 yard
Fabric 8	10518-N	1/2 yard
Backing	4 yards	

Strip Sets (abreviated to SST)

Sew the following strip sets and subcut into:

F1/F2: 3 sets cut into (16) 5-1/2" units

F3/F4: 4 sets cut into (16) 8" units

F1/F5: 3 sets cut into (16) 5-1/2" units

F6/F7: 4 sets cut into (16) 8" units

Cutting

Fabric 1

Cut (21) 3" x WOF strips

Reserve (6) 3" x WOF strips for strip sets. From 5 cut (32) 3" x 5-1/2" A rectangles from 8 cut (32) 3" x 10-1/2" B rectangles Bottom Border: Sew the remaining 2 together, end to end.

Setting Triangles (ST)

Cut (4) 15" squares. Cut twice on the diagonal. (see p.2)

Corner Triangles (CT)

Cut (2) 8" squares. Cut once on the diagonal. (see p. 2)

Fabric 2 and Fabric 5


Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips

Fabrics 3, 4, 6, and 7

Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips

Fabric 8 Binding

Cut (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end to end.



^{*}There will be some left over of each strip set.

^{**}Press seams open.

All Our Hearts Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'. Press seams open.

Make the Right Heart Blocks - Blue

Note: You will be sewing mirror image blocks. Follow the layouts in the illustrations.



- 2. Sew an SST2-Blue unit to the bottom of the step one unit. Press.
- 4. Sew an F1-B rectangle to the **right** side of the step 2 unit. Press.

Repeat to make 10 Right Heart Blocks - Blue.

Make 10 10-1/2" x 10-1/2"

Make the Left Heart Blocks - Blue

- 1. Sew an F1-A rectangle to the **left** side of an SST1-Blue unit. Press.
- 2. Sew an SST2-Blue unit to the bottom of the step one unit. Press.
- 4. Sew an F1-B rectangle to the **left** side of the step 2 unit. Press.

Repeat to make 6 Left Heart Blocks - Blue.

Make 6 10-1/2" x 10-1/2"

Make the Right Heart Blocks -Red

Note: You will be sewing mirror image blocks. Follow the layouts in the illustrations.

- 1. Sew an F1-A rectangle to the **right** side of an SST1-Red unit. Press.
- 2. Sew an SST2-Red unit to the bottom of the step one unit. Press.
- 4. Sew an F1-B rectangle to the **right** side of the step 2 unit. Press.

Repeat to make 10 Right Heart Blocks - Red.

Make 10 10-1/2" x 10-1/2"

Make the Left Heart Blocks - Red

- 1. Sew an F1-A rectangle to the **left** side of an SST1-Red unit. Press.
- 2. Sew an SST2-Red unit to the bottom of the step one unit. Press.
- 4. Sew an F1-B rectangle to the **left** side of the step 2 unit. Press.

Repeat to make 6 Left Heart Blocks - Red.

Left Heart Blocks




Make 6 10-1/2" x 10-1/2"

Top Assembly

The blocks are assembled in rows on-point. Follow the illustration for the placement of the right and left blocks. Corner Triangles are abreviated to CT and Setting Triangles to ST.


- 1. Lay out the rows as shown below alternating the left and right, red and blue blocks and adding the corner and setting triangles as illustrated.
- 2. Sew rows together. Press.
- 3. Sew row to row. Press.



Top Assembly (Continued)

Measure the width of the quilt top. Cut the bottom border to this measurement. Sew the border to the bottom of the quilt.

For best results, pin the center of the \dot{b} order to the center of the quilt top and pin out to the edges.



Bottom Border *Measure your quilt top

Finishing

- 1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
- 2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
