

Fabrics 1-18

a. Pieced blocks, cut from each of (36) squares, (4) 1 1/2" x 10" strips.
Subcut (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2", (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2", (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" and (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles.
(1) 3 1/4" x 10" strip.
Subcut (2) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares.

Background

a. Pieced blocks (6) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (72) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares. (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (36) 2" x 5" rectangles. (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (36) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (24) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles. (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (24) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. b. Sashing rectangles (3) 9 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. c. Inner border (7) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 1/4" x 62" and (2) 3 1/4" x 67 1/2" strips.

Fabric 19

a. Pieced blocks
(1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip.
Subcut (12) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" and (12) 1 1/2" x 8
1/2" rectangles. b. Cornerstones
(2) 2" x WOF strips.
Subcut (25) 2" x 2" squares.
c. Binding
(8) 2 1/4" x WOF strips.
Piece strips to make a binding strip

WOF - Width of Fabric LOF - Length of Fabric RST - Right Sides Together HST - Half Square Triangle

Pirouette Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowances are 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1.


Constructing Pieced Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" Background square. Place square, right sides together, on a color square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units with 45 degree line on quilting ruler. Square and trim units to measure 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" unfinished.

Make a total of (4) units, and sew together to make a pinwheel unit. Unit measures 5" x 5" unfinished.

- 2. Add the following pieces to step 1 unit, starting from left and then bottom, in counter-clockwise direction, to complete (1) pieced block. Pieced block measures
- 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished.
- (1) 2" x 5" Background rectangle
- (1) $2" \times 6 \frac{1}{2}"$ Background rectangle (1)
- 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" color rectangle
- (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" color rectangle
- (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" Background rectangle
- (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Background rectangle
- (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" color rectangle
- (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" color rectangle.

Make a total of (2) blocks for: Fabrics 2, 3, 5, 7, 12, 13, 17, 18 Make a total of (1) block for: Fabrics 4, 6, 8, 9, 11,14, 15,16 3. Repeat to make the following blocks, substituting the Background 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces for Fabric 19 pieces.



Make a total of (2) blocks for: Fabrics 1, 10 Make a total of (1) block for: Fabrics 4, 6, 8, 9, 11,14, 15,16




Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placement and orientation, arrange and sew together (6) pieced blocks, alternating with (5) 2" x 9 1/2" Background rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (6) pieced rows.
- 2. Piece sashing rows. Sew together (6) $2'' \times 9 \cdot 1/2''$ Background rectangles, alternating with (5) $2'' \times 2''$ Fabric 19 squares, to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (5) pieced sashing rows.
- 3. Quilt center. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.
- 4. Outer border. Sew (2) 3 1/4" x 62" Background strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3 1/4" x 67 1/2" Background strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.




Finishing

- Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
 Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
 Bind to complete the quilt.
