





A Block Mixer Project

The Forget Me Not quilt is made with blocks that are pieced with 3 different sections and mixed-up to create the look of improvisational piecing. Follow our pattern or mix-up the sections for your own unique design.

Cutting Size Guide

A rectangles - 1-1/2" x 2-1/2"

B squares - 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

C rectangles - 2-1/2" x 3-1/2"

D rectangles - 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

E rectangles - 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Cutting

Fabric 1

A (10) rectangles B (5) squares E (10) rectangles

Fabric 2

A (10) rectangles B (10) squares C (5) rectangles D (5) rectangles

Fabric 3

C (5) rectangles D (5) rectangles E (15) rectangles

Fabric 4

A (10) rectangles B (5) squares D (5) rectangles

Fabric 5, 6

A (10) rectangles B (5) squares

Fabric 7

A (10) rectangles B (5) squares C (5) rectangles

Fabric 8

B (5) squares C (10) rectangles E (10) rectangles

Fabric 9

A (10) rectangles D (5) rectangles E (10) rectangles

Fabric 10

A (10) rectangles B (5) squares C (10) rectangles D (5) rectangles

Fabric 11

B (10) squares

Fabric 12

B (5) squares

WOF - Width of Fabric LOF - Length of Fabric RST - Right Sides Together HST - Half Square Triangle


Forget Me Not Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. Press in the direction of arrows.

Block Sections

There are 3 sections that make up the blocks. Each section has 4 versions and will be labeled by section, for example Section 1, unit A is S1a.

Follow the layouts as illustrated.



Blocks

There are 2 blocks and each has two layouts. These are labeled Block 1A, Block 1B, Block 2C, and Block 2D. Blocks are 8-1/2' x 8-1/2" unfinished.

Press seams open

Block 1A

Sew the following units together: S1a - S2e - S3i - S1b Note that S1b is turned so the E rectangle is at the top. Press open. Make 5.

Block 1A - Make 5

Block 1B

Sew the following units together: S1c - S2g - S3k - S1d Note that S1d is turned so the E rectangle is at the top. Press open. Make 5.







Block 1B - Make 5

Block 2C

Sew the following units together: S3j - S1a - S1b - S2f Note the direction each unit is rotated. Press open. Make 5.






Block 2C - Make 5

Block 2D

Sew the following units together. S3I - S1d - S1c - S2h Note the direction each unit is rotated. Press open. Make 5.






Block 2D - Make 5

Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Lay out the blocks as shown below. Make (2) of Row 1.
- 2. Sew blocks into rows. Press to nest seams.
- 3. Sew rows together. Press in one direction.




Finishing

- 1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
- 2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.

Alternate Fabric Option Idea

You can use different strips to piece the units for variation. In this version below, we switched out fabrics F1-E and F10-C with the light blue and dark yellow in the strips and used the same layout. Have fun playing with the fabrics and layout for an improv look.
