WOF - Width of Fabric

LOF - Length of Fabric

RST - Right Sides Together

HST - Half Square Triangle



Cut a square once on the diagonal

Cutting

Note: for fabrics 2, 6, 7, and 8
Cut the large square first and then
cut the smaller squares from the remaining
fabric.

Fabric 1:

Cut (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
(36) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 2:

Cut (1) 9-7/8" square. Cut once on diagonal
Cut (7) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 3

Cut (4) 3-12" x WOF strips into
(39) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 4

Cut (28) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 5

Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
(39) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 6

Cut (1) 9-7/8" square. Cut once on diagonal
Cut (49) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 7

Cut (1) 9-7/8" square. Cut once on diagonal
Cut (68) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 8

Cut (1) 9-7/8" square. Cut once on diagonal.
Cut (20) 3-1/2" squares.

Fabric 9

Cut (5) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
(60) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 10

Cut (6) 18-7/8" squares. Cut once on diagonal.

Binding Cut (8) strips 2-1/4" x WOF

Lovely Bunch Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. Press in the direction of arrows.

Use the ☐ check boxes to mark each step as you complete it.

Nine Patch 1 Units (NP1)

Gather (7) F2, (28) F3, and (28) F4 squares

☐ 1. Sew the squares into rows as shown to the right. Press in the direction of the arrows.



☐ 2. Sew row to row. Press. Units measure 9-1/2" square. Make 7 Nine patch 1 units.

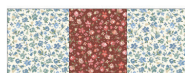

Gather (20) F5, (5) F6, and (20) F8 squares

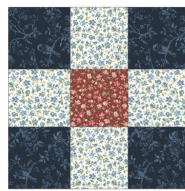
☐ 3. Repeat steps 1-2. Make 5 Nine Patch 2 units.

Gather (19) F5, (68) F7, and (60) F9 squares

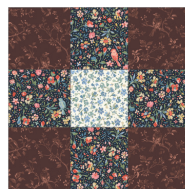
☐ 4. Repeat steps 1-2 to make 11 Nine Patch 3 units and 8 Partial Nine Patch 3 units.



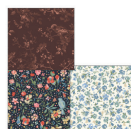

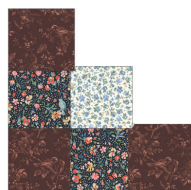

Nine Patch 4 and Partial Nine Patch 4 Units (NP4)

Gather (36) F1, (13) F3, and (44) F6 squares

- ❑ 5. Repeat steps 1-2 to make 5 Nine Patch 4 units and 8 Partial Nine Patch 4 units.

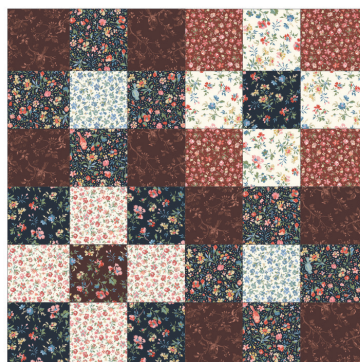

Center Section A

Gather (2) Nine Patch 1 Units, (4) Nine Patch 3 units, and (2) Nine Patch 4 units

- ❑ 6. Sew Nine Patch units together as shown to the right. Press. Make 2. The Center Section measures 18-1/2" square.

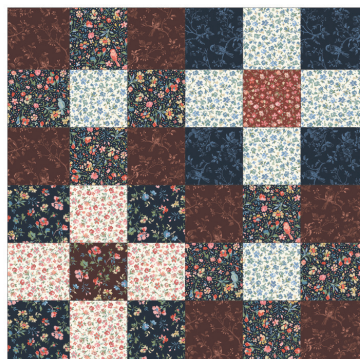


Center Section A - Make 2

Gather (2) Nine Patch 1 units, (2) Nine Patch 2 units, and (4) Nine Patch 3 units

- ❑ 7. Repeat Step 6.

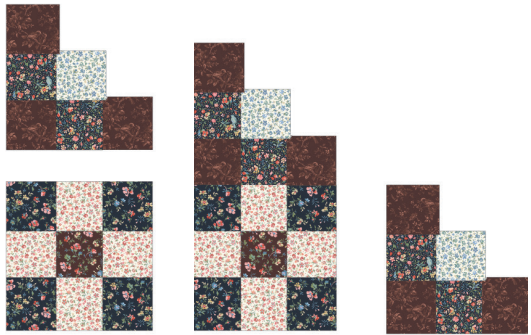

Side Section C

Gather (4) Partial NP3 units, (2) NP1 units, and (2) F10 triangles

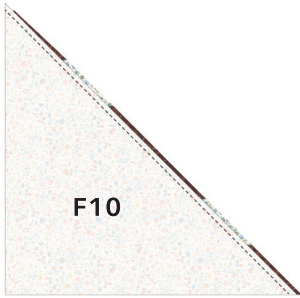
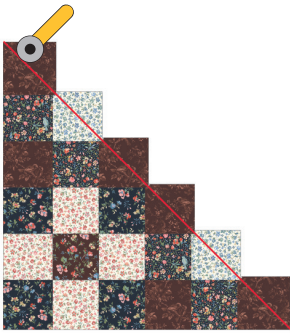
- ❑ 8. Sew a partial NP unit to the top of the NP unit as shown to the right. Press.
- ❑ 9. Add a partial NP unit to the side of the NP unit as shown to the right. Press.
- ❑ 10. Trim this new unit on the diagonal, as illustrated with a red line.
- ❑ 11. Place a F10 triangle on top, RST, and sew along the diagonal. Press. Make 2.



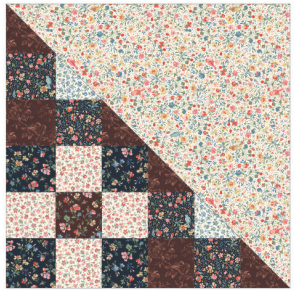

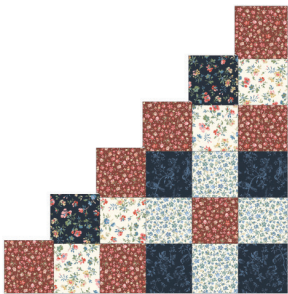

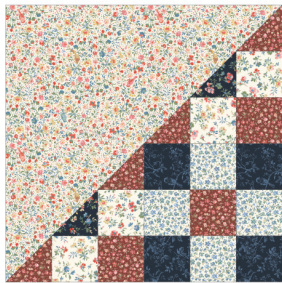
Side Section D

Gather (4) Partial NP4 units, (2) NP2 units, and (2) F10 triangles

- ❑ 12. Repeat steps 8-11, paying close attention to the placement of the units.

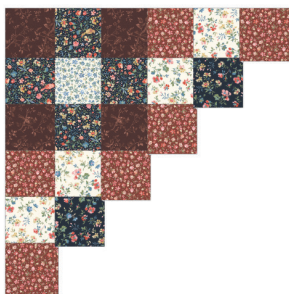

Side Section E

Gather (4) Partial NP4 units, (2) NP3 units, and (2) F10 triangles

- ❑ 13. Sew a partial NP unit to the bottom of the NP unit as shown below. Press.
- ❑ 14. Add a partial NP unit to the side of the NP unit as shown below. Press.
- ❑ 15. Trim this new unit on the diagonal.
- ❑ 16. Place a F10 triangle on top, RST, and sew along the diagonal. Press. Make 2.

Side Section measures 18-1/2" square.

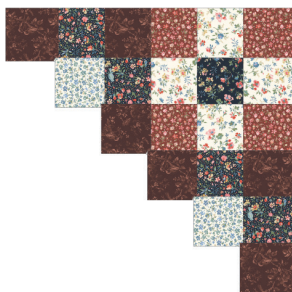

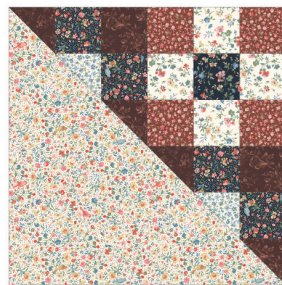
Side Section F

Gather (4) Partial NP3 units, (2) NP4 units, and (2) F10 triangles

- ❑ 17. Repeat steps 13-16, paying close attention to the placement of the units.

Corner Section G

Gather (1) NP1, (2) F8 triangles, and (1) F10 triangle

❑ 18. Sew a F8 triangle to the side of the NP unit. Press.

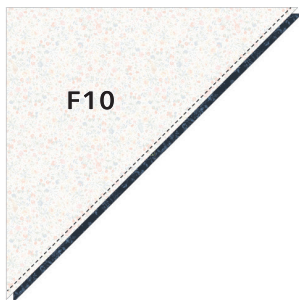
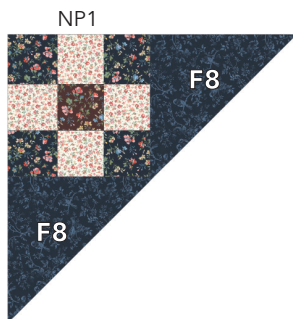
❑ 19. Sew the other F8 triangle to the bottom of the NP unit. Press.

❑ 20. Place a F10 triangle on top, RST, and sew along the diagonal. Press.

Make 1.

The Corner Section measures 18-1/2" square.

❑ 21. Repeat for the remaining corner units H, I, and J, paying close attention to the orientation of the triangles.

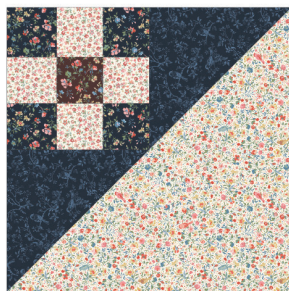
Gather (1) NP2, (2) F2 triangles, and (1) F10 triangle

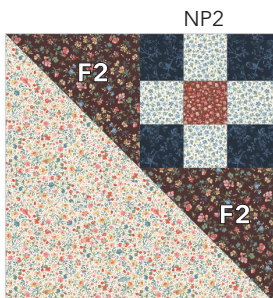

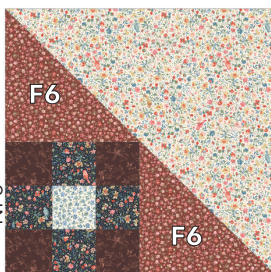

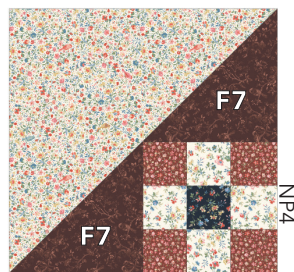

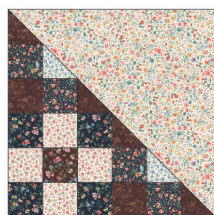
Quilt Top

❑ 22. Lay the Sections into rows as illustrated below. Sew into rows. Press in one direction.

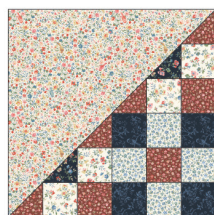
❑ 23. Sew row to row. Press in one direction.



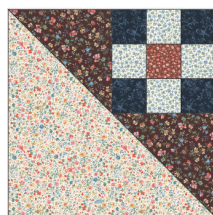

Finishing

❑ 24. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

❑ 25. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
