Cutting

Fabrics 1, 2, 3, and 5

Subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 12" rectangles.

B (4) 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

C (3) 3-1/2" Squares

A Cut (3) 3-1/2" x WOF Strip.

Subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 12" rectangles.

B Cut (4) 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

C Cut (3) 3-1/2" squares

D Cut (3) 3-1/2" x WOF Strip.

Subcut (20) 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.

E Cut (2) 3-1/2" x WOF Strips.

Subcut (10) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.

F Cut (10) 3-1/2" squares

G Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF Strips

Subcut (20) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

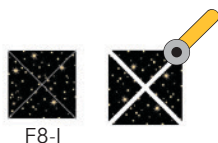
Woven Wreaths Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4. Fabric is abbreviated as by number. For example, Fabric 1 is '1'. Press in the direction of the arrows.

Center Wreath Blocks

HST (Half Square Triangles)

1. Mark and cut (1) F8-I square twice on the diagonal.
2. Mark and cut (1) F4-C square twice on the diagonal.
3. Sew an F8-I triangle to an F4C triangle, RST (right sides together). Press. Make 4 HST units.
4. Sew the remaining HST units as pictured to the right: N/C, O/C, O/F, N/F, N/O
5. Lay the HSTs in 4 rows as illustrated below. Include (2) F8-M squares in the lower corners.
6. Sew into rows and then sew row to row. Press. Make 2.

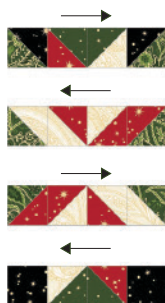
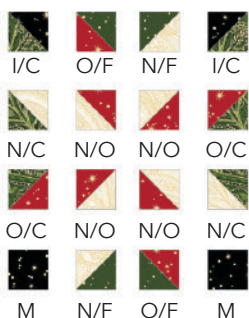

7. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on an F8-M square. Place RST over an F4-B rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from your stitched line. Repeat making a mirror-image unit. Press. Make 2 pairs.

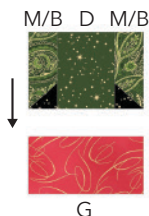

8. Sew the step 7 M/B units to either side of a F6-D rectangle. Press. Make 2.
9. Sew the step 8 section to an F7-G rectangle.
10. Sew the step 9 section to the Step 6 units. Press. Make 2.
11. Repeat steps 1- 10 to make the following Center Wreath Blocks. For each block you will replace the C squares and the B rectangles with the fabric indicated below. Make 2 of each. Illustrations p. 5

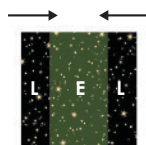
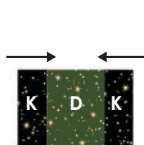

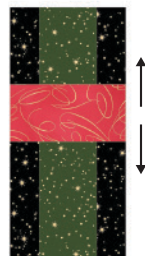
Ribbon Sections

1. Sew an F 8-K rectangle to either side of an F6-D rectangle. Press. Make 10.
2. Sew a Fabric 8-L rectangle to either side of an Fabric 6-E rectangle. Press. Make 10.
3. Sew the rectangle units to either side of an F7-G rectangle. Press. Make 10.

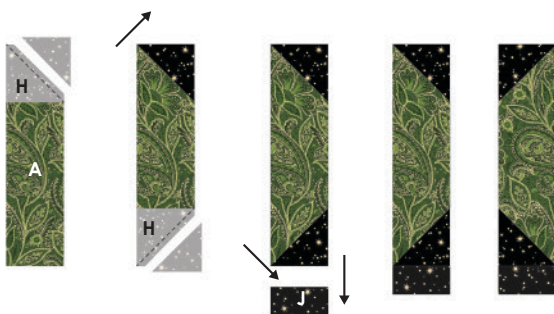


Side Wreath Sections (below)

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on a F8-H square. Place the F8-H square, RST over a F4-A rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the stitched line. Press.
2. Repeat on the opposite end, making sure to stitch from the opposite corner as illustrated.
3. Sew an F8-J rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press. Make 2.
4. Repeat these steps to make a mirror-image unit. Press. Make 4 sets.
5. Repeat step 4 to make the Wreath Side Unit pairs pictured on p.6. Make 2 sets of each pair.

Wreath Blocks

1. Sew the F4 wreath side units to either side of the F4 wreath center blocks. Press. Make 2.
2. Repeat to make the Wreath Blocks pictured below. Make 2 of each.

Top Assembly

1. Sew the wreath blocks, ribbon blocks, and side wreath blocks into 4 rows following the illustration on p.7.
2. Sew row to row Press rows to nest and press open when joining the rows.

Inner Borders

1. Sew the F11 strips together, end to end, into one continuous strip. Cut into (2) 52-1/2" inner side borders (2) 50-1/2" inner top and bottom borders.
2. Sew the inner borders to each side of the quilt. Press.
3. Sew the inner borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press.

Outer Borders

1. Sew the F12 border strips together, end to end, into one continuous strip. Cut into (2) 54-1/2" outer side borders (2) 62-1/2" outer top and bottom borders.
2. Sew the outer borders to each side of the quilt top. Press.
3. Sew the outer borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press.

Tip for sewing borders: Measure your quilt top. Trim the borders to this measurement. Pin the borders from the center out to the ends before sewing. Press away from center.



Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
