Fabric 1	MAS513-KW	3 yards
Fabric 2	MAS513-SW2	7/8 yard
Binding	MAS513-BQ4	1/2 yard
Backing	4 yards	

Cutting for either colorway

A Cut (16) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares

Fabric 1 - Background

Cut (31) 2-1/2" x WOF strips into

B (160) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares

C (16) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

D (16) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

E (16) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

F (16) 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles

Cut (6) 4-1/2" x WOF strips into

G (16) 4-1/2" squares

H (16) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 2 - Stars

Cut (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips into

I (128) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares


Cut (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips into

J (16) 4-1/2" X 4-1/2" squares

Fabric 3 Binding

Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end to end.

Super Star Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. Press seams open.

Note: Illustrations show the Spectrum Colorway.

Make the Star Units

Gather: (16) light pink squares, (16) purple squares, (160) F1-B squares, (96) F2 I-squares, and (16) F2 J-squares.

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (96) F1 squares. Cut 1/4" away from the marked line.

2. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (128) F2 squares. Cut 1/4" away from the marked line.

3. Place an F1 triangle, RST over an F2 triangle. Sew on the marked line. Make 96. Press.

4. Repeat steps 1-3 pairing the F1 pink and purple triangles with the F2 gold triangles. Make 16.

5. Sew a white/gold HST to a purple/gold HST, as shown to the right. Press. Make 16 HST pairs.

6. Repeat step 5 with the white/gold and pink/gold HSTs. Make 16 HST pairs.


7. Repeat step 5 with the remaining 64 white/gold HSTs. Make 32 HST pairs.

8. Sew an F1-B square to opposite sides of the (16) pink/gold units and the (16) white/gold units. Press.




9. Sew the purple/white/gold unit and the white gold unit to opposite sides of the F2 J-square. Make sure the points face in toward the J-square.

10. Sew the step 8 units to the step 9 unit. Make sure the points face toward the J-square. Make 16. Press.

HST Units




HST Pairs



Make the Right Sections


1. Gather (16) each of 5 different red, pink, and orange squares.
2. Sew (16) pair of orange/pink squares together. Press. Sew those pair to the F1-G squares.
3. Sew (16) sets of three pink/red squares together, Press. Sew those units to the F1-C rectangles. Press.
4. Sew together steps 2 and 3 as illustrated. Press.
5. Sew the step 4 unit to the top of the Star unit. Press. Make 16.

Make the Left Sections

1. Gather (16) each of 10 different orange, green, blue, and purple squares.
2. Sew (16) sets of 3 orange/green squares together. Press.
3. Sew (16) sets of 3 blue/purple squares together. Press.
4. Sew (16) sets of 4 green/blue squares together, Press. Sew those units to the F1-H rectangles. Press.
5. Sew the sets of 3 orange/green to the top and the blue/purple to the bottom of the step 4 units. Make 16. Press.
6. Sew an F1-E rectangle to the left side of the step 5 unit. Press.
7. Sew an F1-D rectangle to the bottom of the step 6 unit. Press.



Finish the Blocks

1. Sew the left side and right side sections together. Press.
2. Sew the F1-F rectangle to the top of the step 1 unit. Press. Make 16.



Row and Quilt Top Assembly

1. Lay out the quilt blocks as shown below. Make sure to follow the orientation of the stars. Make two each of Row 1 and Row 2.
2. Sew blocks into rows. Press in one direction to nest seams.
3. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top. Press.



Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
